UCSF Lease Adds Medical Facilities Near Mission Bay

February 28, 2003 - UCSF has signed a 15-year lease for 50,000 square feet at China Basin Landing.

The university plans to house its department of radiology there, which will include an imaging center for patients as well as office and research space.

There are two advantages to locating there, said a university spokeswoman: "To be near Mission Bay and the research work going on there, plus the N Judah stops two blocks away, so it's very convenient for patients."

UCSF's medical research building, Genentech Hall, is already complete at its 43-acre Mission Bay campus, and several buildings are under way. Additionally, the university is planning to develop a \$100 million cancer research facility at the campus.
